1. We have received emails from a few parents stating their inability to permit their ward's participation in the upcoming **Republic Day Celebration on 26 January 2026** Annual Sports Day Drill Practices, citing personal or medical reasons.

2. We would like to clearly state that, as per CBSE guidelines and the **National Education Policy (NEP 2020)**, schools are mandated to focus on the holistic development of children, which includes physical education, co-curricular activities, national celebrations, and value-based programs, in addition to academics. Accordingly, participation in Republic Day and Sports Day forms an essential and compulsory part of the school curriculum and is not treated as an optional activity.

3. **Republic Day** inculcates patriotism, civic responsibility, discipline, and respect for the Constitution, while Sports Day develops physical fitness, teamwork, leadership, resilience, and sportsmanship. These experiences significantly contribute to a child's long-term personality development and emotional well-being.

4. Please note that **repeated non-participation**, except in cases of genuine medical reasons supported by valid medical documentation, may result in students:

- Missing opportunities for team selection, leadership roles, and school representations
- Being excluded from inter-school competitions and future events
- Losing vital exposure required for holistic assessment & skill development, as emphasized by CBSE

5. We strongly urge parents to align with the **school's educational vision** and encourage their children to participate actively in both events. Parental cooperation is crucial in ensuring that students do not miss formative experiences that shape their confidence, character, and future readiness.

6. **In case of legitimate medical concerns**, kindly submit the relevant medical advice to the class teacher for record purposes and necessary accommodation.
