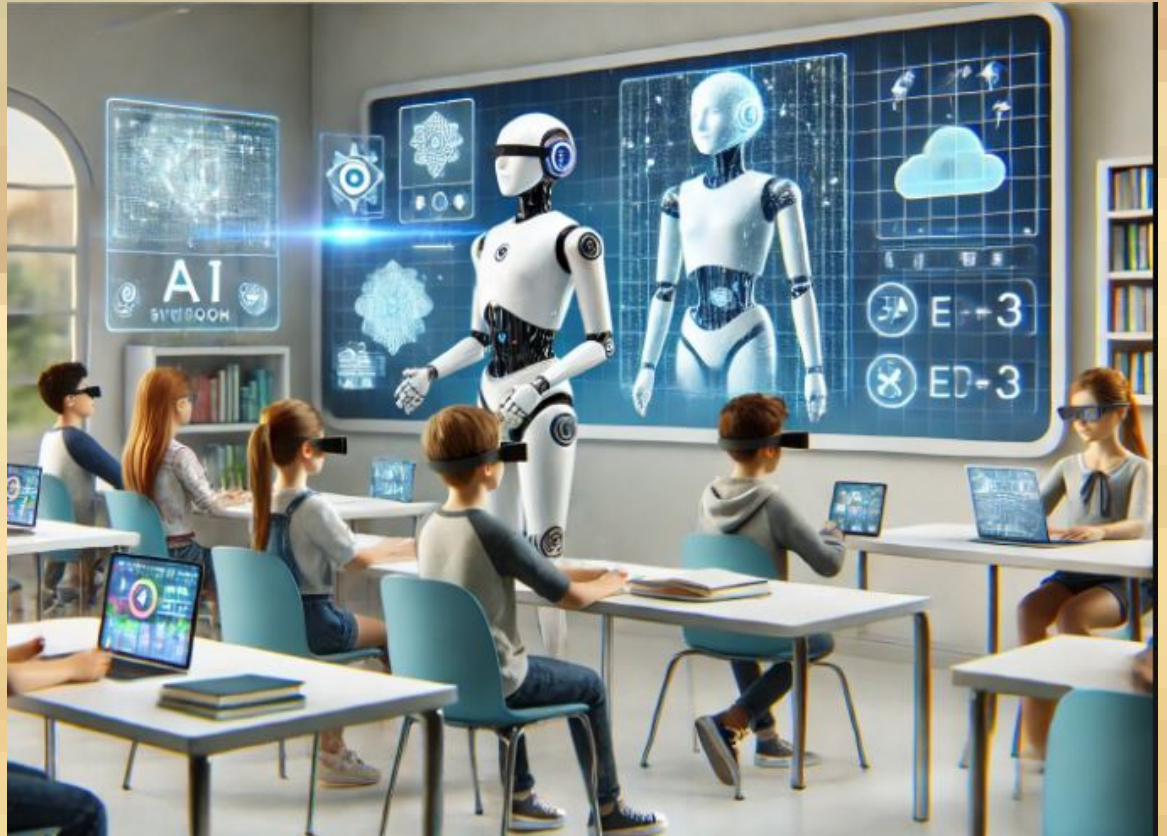

Will AI take over teaching?

Artificial Intelligence is a catalogue of technologies that enable computers, and related machineries attain intelligence on par with the human brain's cognizant skills such as problem solving, decision making, forecasting and Natural Language Understanding.

Artificial Intelligence is reliant on metadata, and it uses data to learn, analyze and produce outcomes in competence to the human brain. Artificial intelligence may not yield accurate results in the first shot. However, with intense deep learning on a specific aspect, outcomes will be refined over time, and it can process new results on different topics with similar learning attained earlier. The pace at which artificial intelligence is scaling and exceeding expectations has kindled mixed emotions in the world.

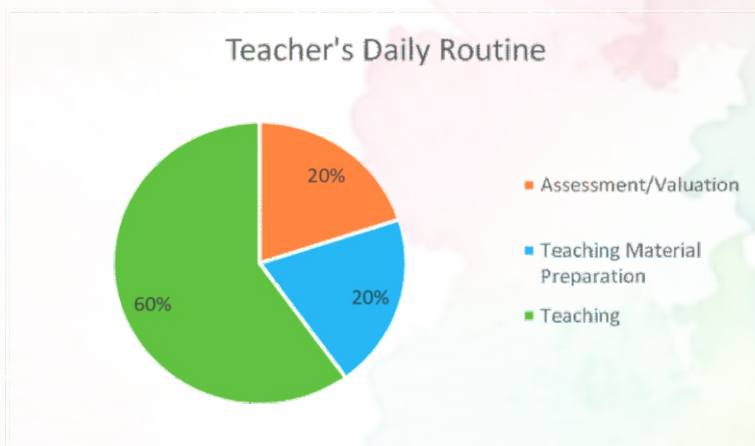
This unsettling behavior is not uncommon when it comes to any disruptive innovations such as Cryptocurrency, Virtual Reality, Robotics, Online Shopping, Social Media etc. that we have witnessed in the past. This tendency will prevail until we get to co-exist with the changing technologies.

With the introduction of Artificial Intelligence (AI), there is no doubt that many blue and white collared jobs will be replaced by AI. When Teaching is a quintessential job for every community, let's see how AI will transform the teaching dynamics.

Before we start, let's have a look at how a normal teacher's routine life is planned in a day at school.

While teaching consumes around 60% of the time, it's also evident that teachers spend considerable time on other administrative activities.

Let's look at the task distribution of teachers in detail and see how we can leverage AI in teaching:

Assessment and Valuation: Includes activities such as preparing exam papers, conducting invigilation and performance assessments.

How can AI help? Generative AI can assist teachers to generate question papers given the curriculum and exam pattern from previous years for each subject and grade.

Preparation and Assignments: Where teachers must find creative ways to explain a concept to students so that it gets simplified.

Generative AI can assist teachers with various illustrations and props that can simplify the materials and time spent on the aspect of preparation. Also, as homework, projects and assignments are a

derivative of the classroom sessions, AI can be leveraged to generate Practical Assignments related to the topics covered in the class.

Teaching: To impart knowledge to students is the cornerstone of the occupation and spending quality time in teaching is vital to the role. Though, Teachers tend to educate the students with the same concepts 90% of the time, each principle or fact is new to the students.

AI can assist the students in capturing the classroom sessions with efficient note taking and revisiting the concepts in their desired language using Natural Language Understanding along with multiple illustrations. Therefore, it will help the students understand the subject better, enriching the learning experience.

In addition to routine activities, teachers are also steering forces of seasonal activities such as School Day, Annual Day, Independence Day, Cultural activities where, AI can aid in content creation like Welcome address, Vote of Thanks, Agenda planning etc. Also, AI can present a platter of the events planned across other schools on similar occasions, simplifying the efforts required from the school committee.

Akin to other professions, it's inevitable that Artificial Intelligence will reshape the role of teaching and will reduce umpteen redundancies in the job. Also, it will create a lot of creative time for the teachers to spend otherwise, in the school with students.

The real question is "what do we need our children to be schooled?". When children are spending one-third of their time in school, obtaining academic excellence is just the tip of the iceberg in a child's overall development. The other development factors that contribute to the stable well-being of an individual are:

Physical development: Motor skills, Athletics, Speech and Language

Social development: positive social ties, Teamwork, Social behavior and Environmental awareness

Emotional Intelligence: Self-awareness, Empathy and Relationship management

Moral development: Civics, Laws and Ethics

We as parents wish for a wholistic personality development in our children. Apart from cognitive development, Artificial Intelligence's ability to scale across other developmental factors is trivial. The void in other non-academic factors can only be fulfilled by teachers. Their individual attention to detail in every student's wholesome development is irreplaceable by AI.

With AI, Teacher's job will evolve into a holistic approach in enabling civil and responsible youngsters in the society. To conclude, it's unlikely for AI to replace the role of teachers, but it will incredibly redefine their role in the school as well as in the community.

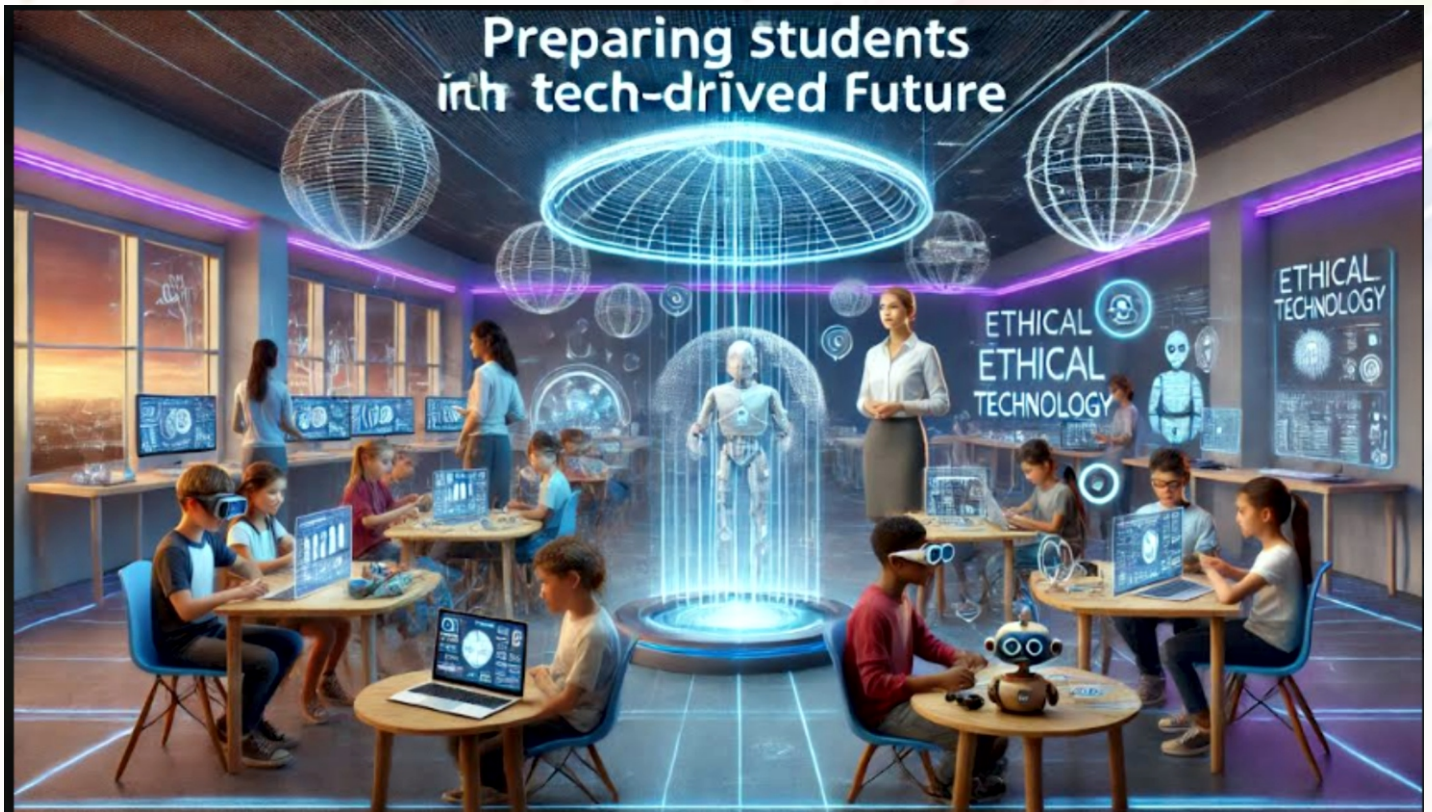

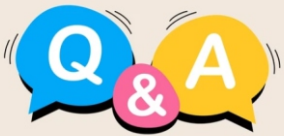

Pediatric Health Discussion Panel

Dear Sir, If my five year old is very active, are naps necessary? If he skips a nap, what is the best time for his last meal? (He doesn't drink milk before bed and usually wakes up around 7 AM in the morning). Also request you to please advise his bedtime based on last meal. ?

"Dearest Parent,

It's truly delightful to hear that your vibrant five-year-old is so full of life! At this stage, daytime naps become optional for many children who enjoy a sufficiently long nighttime sleep (generally 10-13 hours). If your child remains energetic and cheerful throughout the day without a nap, it's perfectly acceptable.

Should Naps Be Skipped

The timing of the evening meal plays a crucial role. Ideally, dinner should be a light affair, served approximately 2-3 hours before bedtime. For instance:

If bedtime is scheduled for 8:00 p.m., aim to serve dinner around 6:00 p.m.

Ensure a balanced meal comprising protein, vegetables, and some wholesome carbohydrates, as these can contribute to feelings of satiety and improve sleep quality.

Regarding Milk Before Bed

Should your child not favor milk, there's no cause for concern! You can offer appealing alternatives such as yogurt, cheese, or even a banana, as these foods are known to promote restful sleep.

Suggested Bedtime

Considering his 7:00 a.m. wake-up time, an ideal bedtime would fall between 8:00 and 8:30 p.m. This timeframe allows for ample hours of rejuvenating sleep.

Should you observe signs of crankiness or fatigue during the day, you may consider reintroducing a brief afternoon rest or a period of quiet time. Remember, every child possesses unique needs, so trust your instincts and attentively observe your child's cues!

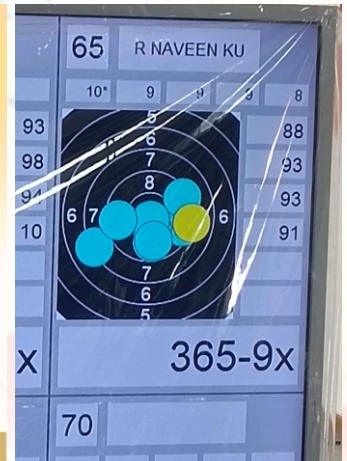
