"Teaching Children through Outdoor Activities"

Introduction

Imagine a scenario, Where Children are collecting pebbles to create a small castle of stones or using a running race to learn the concept of cardinal and ordinal numbers.

To teach children, concepts need to be deeply instilled into their young minds and this takes more than just conventional classroom teaching. In an age where children are easily distracted and crave engagement, the practice of teaching children through outdoor activities helps to keep them engaged and learn in an interactive manner.

The focus on make-oriented rote memory education is getting antiquated in several parts of the world and being replaced by interactive teaching models to keep up with the changing attention spans and educational needs of the modern day child.

Outdoor teaching enables children to think, where instead of learning with a projector and screen, they are inspired to use the sky as the canvas on which they paint their ideas.











Benefits of Teaching through Outdoor Activities:

Teaching out in the open is one of the best ways to break the monotony of a regular classroom and is recommended as one of the most effective teaching techniques by several top educational models in the world. The benefits of teaching through outdoor activities have been listed below.

- 1 It is scientifically proven that experiential learning is more likely to lead to greater retention of concepts in memory. Children are more likely to remember a concept through experience than through an explanation from a textbook.
- 1 Activity driver learning kinaesthetically improves a child's well-being, mentally and physically contributing to a healthier life for children.
- 1 When children are allowed to learn in open spaces, their creativity increases manifold and they are more enthusiastic and motivated to get involved in the learning process. In this scenario, children can be taught difficult concepts more easily.
 - 1 Outdoor learning helps children develop their social skills through group activities.

In Short, when the mind is open and stress-free, attitudes towards learning are encouraged and a joyful environment is established.

Making Teaching Outdoors Interesting and Effective

Teaching and learning should never be a mundane experience for both the teacher and the student. In our experience as an educator, we have always followed four cardinal pillars of teaching –communication, collaboration, creativity and critical thinking, which are universally accepted new generation skills. An additional but important element we believe in is confidence.

It is only when students are exposed to experiential learning that they get confidence and one of the great methods of experiential learning is to teach them outdoors to get hands-on experience. Instances where the school has implemented outdoor teaching methods, include,

- Children go through the exercise of a nature walk and learn simple concepts like the different parts of plants to more complex concepts, like dicotyledon and monocotyledon.
- 1 Recently, in Bangalore, a sky watch was conducted at school where the children were shown a rare phenomenon called 'Brahma Dhanush'.
- 1 We had simulated a simple shopping experience, where children were asked to go buy something from a shop and then asked to do the basic mathematics for the transaction.

Multiple other innovative projects have been implemented by the school to encourage learning outdoors, including through theatre, dance, music, yoga and sport.

Effectiveness of teaching outdoors

The experience has been largely positive for both teachers and students. Students find the experience of outdoor learning more enriching and the application of the concepts they learn in an outdoor environment has been more.

For teaching, it is a welcome change from the confines of the classroom, and also, challenges them to come up with scenarios and different methods to use outdoor means to teach concepts; It, therefore, fosters innovation among teachers.

Promoting Teaching through Outdoor Activity

Schools are slowly warming up to the concept of outdoor-based learning and this can be accelerated by encouraging teachers to devise new lessons using non-classroom methods.

Our recommendation would be to use everyday scenarios like buying from a shop, going to a bank or playing a sport to teach various concepts. For instance, organizing a cricket match to teach children the concept of counting and basic arithmetic helps them retain the concept in their minds. This ensures that students understand the application of concepts in their everyday lives and are prepared for these scenarios when they grow up.



Halloween Celebration




















